

# **GREENLAND**

Hunting in Greenland is an unforgettable Arctic experience. Greenland is one of the largest islands. You will hunt with local "Inuit" guides near the beautiful cities Sisimuit and Kangerlussuaq (Søndre Strømfjord). They will ensure that you have a safe and successful hunt. During the fall hunt temperatures will be between +50 °F (+10 °C) to +77 °F (+25 °C) during the day and +41 °F (+5 °C) to +50 °F (+10 °C) during the night. It is getting way colder in winter and temperatures of 14 °F (-10 °C) to -13 °F (-25 °C) are possible. You will be accommodated in cabins and tents during the hunt. There will be electricity from a generator. Breakfast and dinner will be served at the camp. During the hunt we will have lunch in the hunting area. The terrain in the hunting area includes flatland, hills, mountains and open fields. We will hunt either by boat, ATV or snowmobile. As soon as we spotted the right animal, we try to get closer on foot to make your hunt successful. Greenland allows to import your own rifle (which is highly recommended), but bow hunting is also allowed.

## **Travel schedule:**

1<sup>st</sup> DAY: Arrival in Kangerlussuaq, via Copenhagen. You will be welcomed at the airport in Kangerlussuaq and stay one night at a hotel, if needed.

2<sup>nd</sup> DAY: The helicopter or boat will take you to your camp. After you are settled in, we will make a test shot and go hunting.

3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> DAY: Hunting.

5<sup>th</sup> DAY: The helicopter or boat will take you back to Kangerlussuaq and take you to the hotel, if needed. Fly home via Copenhagen.

NOTE: We highly recommend staying a few days before or after your hunt in Copenhagen to enjoy this beautiful, European city. You can explore the city on your own or do a guided sightseeing tour. Their traditional cuisine, beer, wine and snaps (Akvavit) will not disappoint you.

Greenland is the world's largest non-continental island and the third largest area in North America after Canada and the United States. Geographically, it belongs to arctic north America. Politically, it is an autonomous part of the Kingdom of Denmark. Greenland has the northernmost land area on earth and is only sparsely populated. The entire population lives on the coast, especially in the west of the country. Greenland has a polar and sub-polar climate. On the west coast, the climate is moderated by the Greenland Stream, which is supplied here with relatively warm water by the North Atlantic Stream and the Gulf Stream. Around 62 miles (100 km) inland, the climate is clearly continental, like Siberia or central Alaska.
