

<u>HUNTING SEASON:</u> Best period is from January – March



PRICE INCLUDES:

- Transport during the hunt (4x4 hunting vehicle)
- 1:1 guiding and an English speaking guide, trackers and helpers / porters
- Accommodation in hunting area (comfortable bungalows with en-suite bathroom)
- All meals and drinks
- Field preparation

PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

- International / domestic air tickets
- Assistance at airport Douala and transfer from / to hotel and hotel cost in Douala (\$800 per hunter)
- Domestic flight from Douala to Ngaoundere (\$550 in economy class, \$950 in business class per person)
- Hotel before / after the hunt
- Trophy fees
- Local communities improvement / development tax (15% on the amount of trophy fees)
- Personal expenses
- Hunting license \$2,800 / per hunter
- Rental rifle \$150 / per day, ammunition \$15 / per bullet
- Visa and rifle import permit (\$650 including one rifle, \$250 per extra rifle)
- Insurance, gratuities
- Forwarding your trophies to Douala, dipping and packing, Vet. Certificates and export permits \$3,000 per hunter
- Trophy packing and shipment to final destination (depending on the country)
- Taxidermist

NOTE: On a 8-day safari you can harvest the Buffalo and Roan Antelope and 4 animals from group B. On a 13-day safari you can harvest 12 different species. 4 from group A and 8 from group B.

Trophy fees can be modified without notice by the local authorities. Wounded animals are considered harvested animals and will be charged at full rate. Double trophy fee for a female or a juvenile. Due to strict quota regulations, please ensure all preferred species are available at time of the booking.
